- To ensure that all immigrants & refugees pregnant women in Baltimore receive early and adequate prenatal care.

All our services are free and provided in French, English & in some African Languages:

- Awareness and prevention education for Diabetes, Blood Pressure, Cancer, STD, HIV/AIDS
- Counseling, Screening & Referral for diabetes and blood pressure treatment
- Counseling & referral of pregnant women to prenatal and postnatal care
- Certified by the Maryland AIDS Administration to provide Counseling, Testing & Referral (CTR) for HIV/AIDS treatment
- Counseling & support for medication adherence
- Nutrition education and referral for food
- Psycho-social support for people infected/affected by HIV/AIDS
- Advocacy for health care services

- Medical interpretation/translation in French and in African languages
- Medical Escort & transportation to medical appointments
- Case management
- Pastoral Counseling & support (optional)
